





- Planned *in vitro* assays using ThioflavinT to confirm inhibition of amyloid fibrillation, along with structural analysis through diffraction-based methods such as X-ray crystallography and Circular Dichroism (CD) spectroscopy.
- *In vivo* evaluation of the synthesized compound by several cognitive studies would be performed using a scopolamine-induced amnesia mice model.






